RESOLUTION 2021-13

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE WEST COAST INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021/2022; REQUESTING INCLUSION OF TAXES INTO MEMBER COUNTY BUDGETS; FURNISHING MEMBER COUNTIES CERTIFIED COPIES OF RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2021, the West Coast Inland Navigation District (the "District") of Lee, Charlotte, Sarasota and Manatee Counties adopted its Tentative Millage Rate for Fiscal Year 2021/2022 at a public hearing in accordance with Section 200.065, Fla. Stat.; and

WHEREAS, the District duly considered the budgetary requirements of the District in adopting its Final Millage Rate for Fiscal Year 2021/2022 at a public hearing in accordance with Section 200.065, Fla. Stat.; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Lee, Charlotte, Sarasota and Manatee Counties has been certified by each respective County Property Appraiser to the District to be a total of \$231,902,936,654.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WEST COAST INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT, A MULTI-COUNTY INDEPENDENT SPECIAL TAX DISTRICT OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, THAT:


1. The Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Final Millage Rate to be levied is hereby set at the rate of 0.0394 mills on the taxable property within the District; and
2. The Final Millage Rate of 0.0394 mills is greater than the current year rolled-back rate of 0.0376 mills by 4.79%, and the percentage increase in property taxes adopted by the District is 4.79%; and
3. Pursuant to the authority vested in the District by the Laws of Florida, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee, Charlotte, Sarasota and Manatee Counties, respectively be, and are hereby requested to include in their budgets for Fiscal Year 2021/2022 an item of taxation at the millage rate of 0.0394 per \$1,000 for the use and benefit of the District, and to assess, levy, collect and remit such tax to Treasurer of the District as provided by law; and
4. Duly certified copies of this Resolution shall be furnished to the respective Board of County Commissioners, Property Appraiser and Tax Collector in each aforesaid county; and
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WEST COAST INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT, A MULTI-COUNTY INDEPENDENT SPECIAL TAX DISTRICT OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, THAT:

1. The attached Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Final Budget be adopted; and
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
